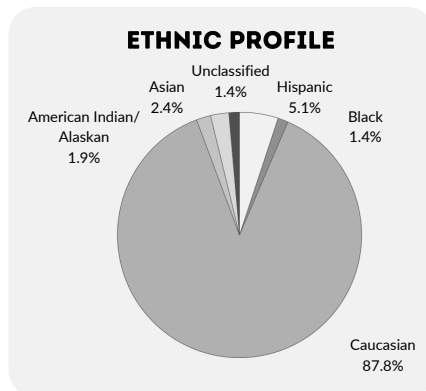

COMMUNITY/SCHOOL INFO

Bozeman High School is located in Bozeman, Montana and is part of Bozeman Public Schools. Bozeman has a population of approximately 53,000 residents (2020) and is one of the fastest growing areas in the state. The economy is based upon agriculture and tourism—with Yellowstone National Park and ski resorts nearby. Montana State University, with 16,766 students, also impacts the economy of this handsome western community.

BHS is four-year comprehensive public school on a two semester, seven period schedule. It is accredited by the Northwest Accreditation Association and the State of Montana. Each 90 day semester course meets daily for 50 minutes and counts for .5 credits. Students have the option to pursue a zero period each year for additional credits. There is a current enrollment of 1,243 students as of September 2021.

Faculty members are regularly recognized at the state, national, and international levels for excellence in their fields. BHS has 95 certified teachers, 4 counselors, and 4 administrators. In collaboration with the Bozeman community, it is the mission of our school "to provide an outstanding education that inspires and ensures high achievement so every student can succeed and make a difference in a rapidly changing world community".



GRADING

The Covid-19 pandemic forced BHS to go 100% remote during the second semester of the 19-20 school year. Because of this, many of our students received Pass/No Pass grades on their transcripts. These grades did not affect the GPA of any student. In 20-21, BHS adopted varied instructional formats as a continued response to Covid-19. Students attended in person for 2 days and remotely for 3 during first semester. Second semester, students attended in person for four days and remotely for one.

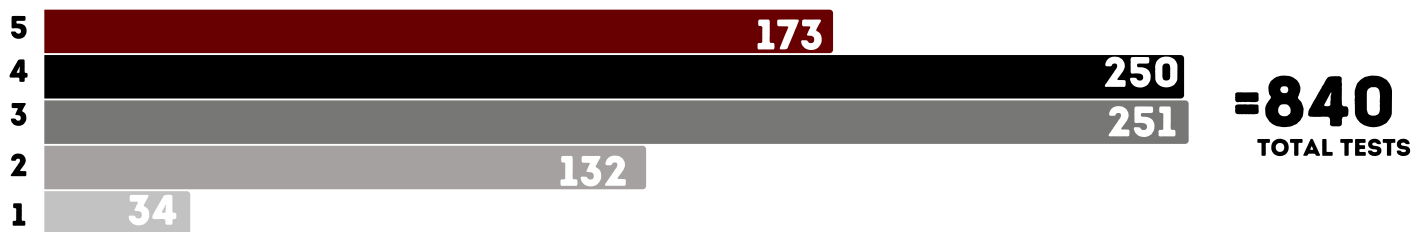

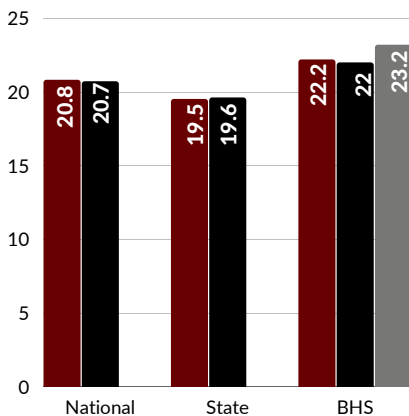
2021 AP TEST RESULTS



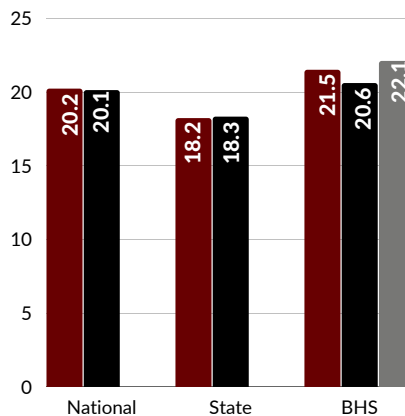
ACT

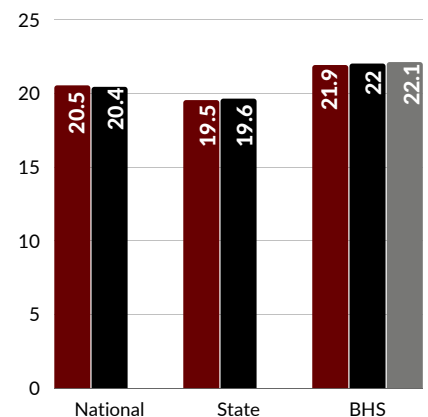
COMPOSITE
